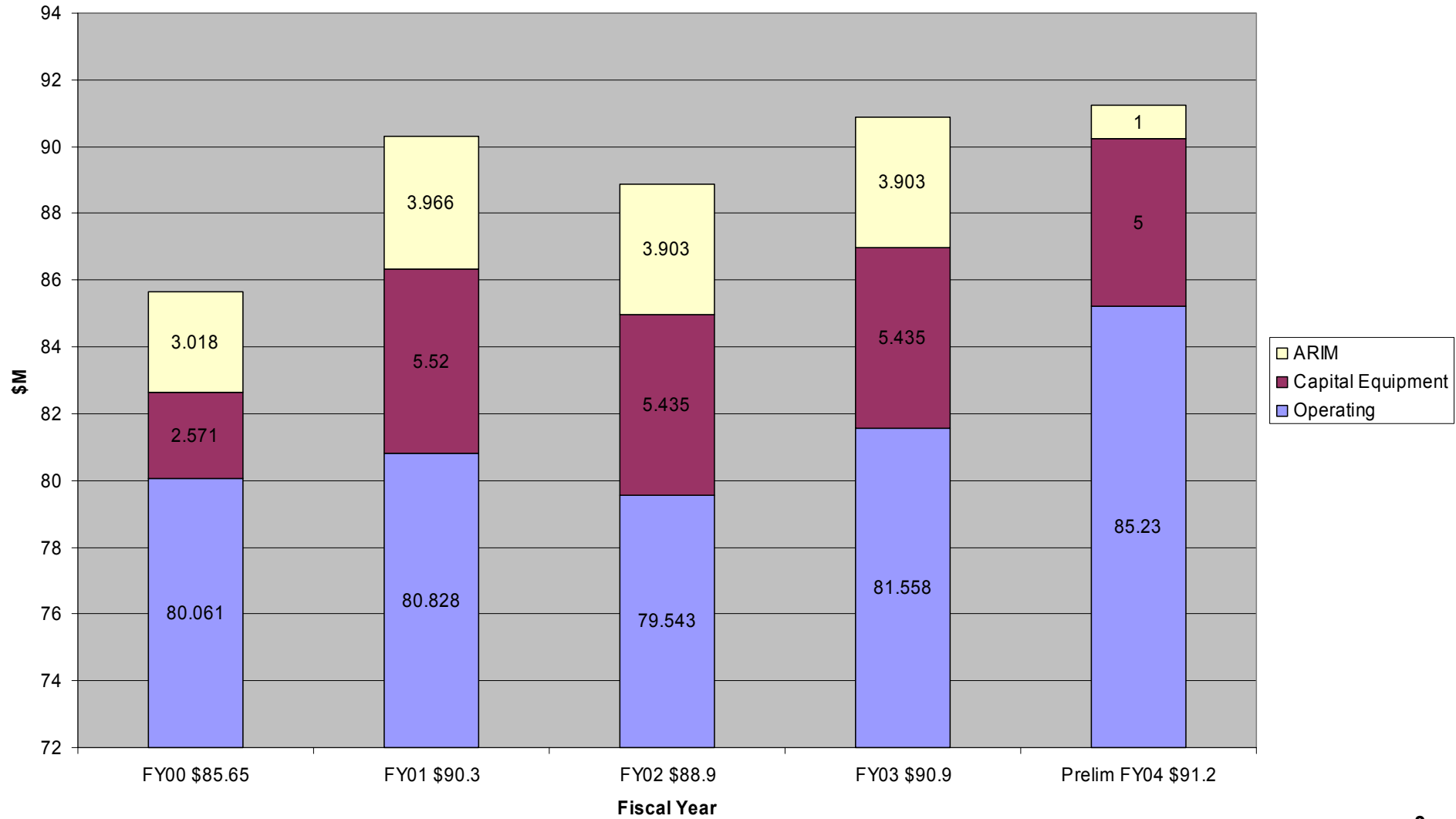

FY04 Budget Projections

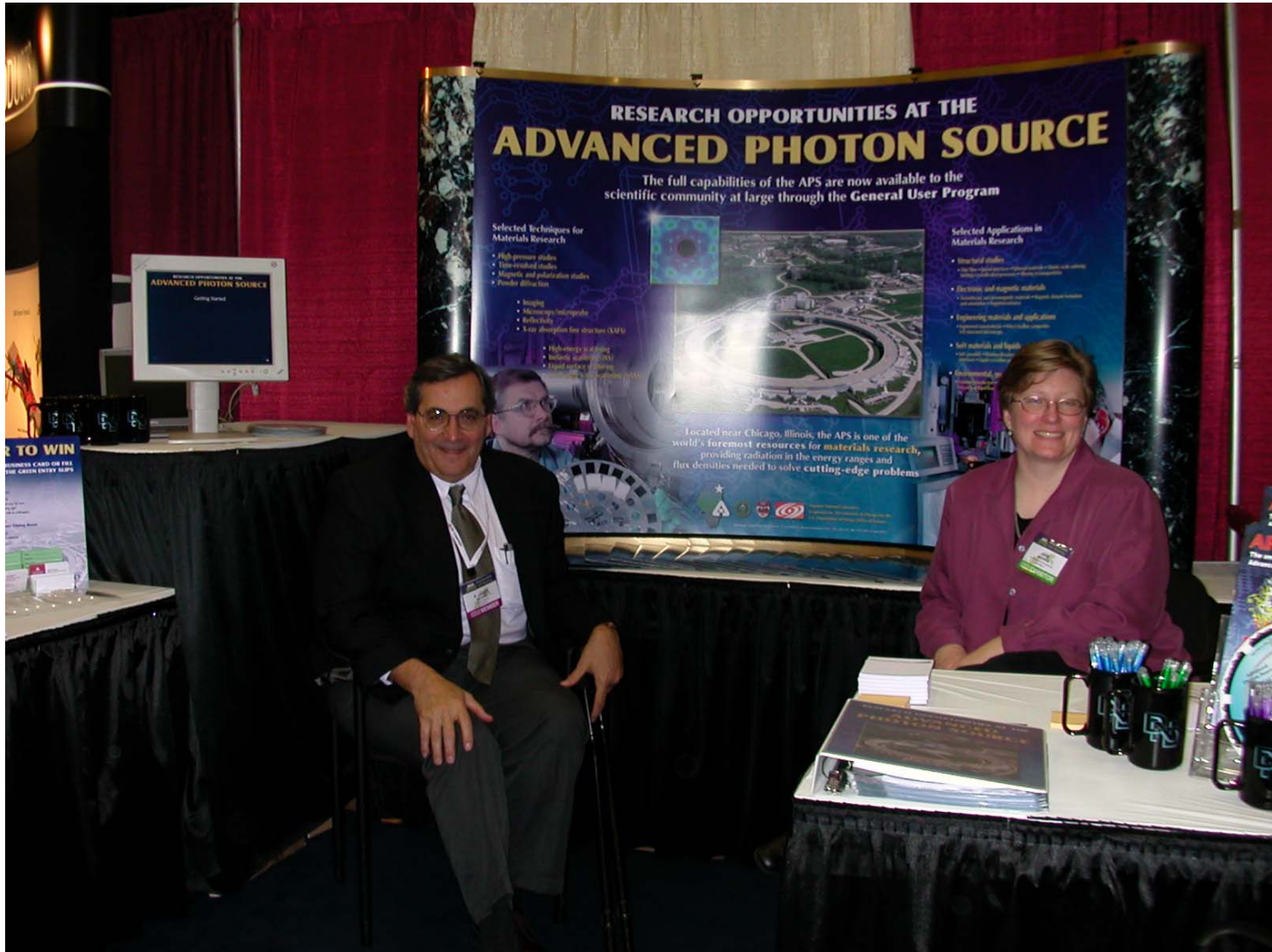

Operations	81.558	85.23	3.67*	4.5
ARIM	3.903	1.00	-2.90	-74.38
Cap. Equip.	5.433	5.00	-0.43	-7.97
Total	90.89	91.23	0.34	0.37

* \$2.4M from the \$8M increase for facilities (influenced by user advocacy)

We can expect ARIM will be restored to last year's level (another \$3M) resulting in a total budget of close to the original President;s budget for FY04, resulting in a increase of about 4% over last year.
