


Argonne has had a recent spate serious incidents that reflect poor work planning and control.

## **APS Upgrade**

- Project getting into gear to move forward with Conceptual Design Report
  - Continuing to work with headquarters on the Mission Need Statement for CD-0
    - Meeting with DEO HQ Dec 11th to "red team" Mission Need Statement went well
  - Expectation has been to complete CD-0 by first quarter Calendar 2010
    - Important to include APS Upgrade in DOE Office of Science strategic planning beginning January 2010 -> this coincides with the 2012 budget
  - Have identified funding milestones for project
    - Need to get CD-1 ~ end of calendar 2010
    - Project funds (long-lead procurements) planned to begin in FY 2012
- Preparing a "strawman" list of beamline upgrades/locations for discussion with community
  - Project team (Dean, Mohan) working with Upgrade Steering Committee (chair Denny Mills)
    - Aim to release something by the end of the calendar year
  - Aim to present to SAC in January 2010
  - A useful template that will allow us to start more detailed planning on the "flagship" beamlines whose location/configuration is clearcut



# Funding Types, Timelines and Schedule Goals




Figure 1. Typical DOE Acquisition Management System for Line Item Projects.
