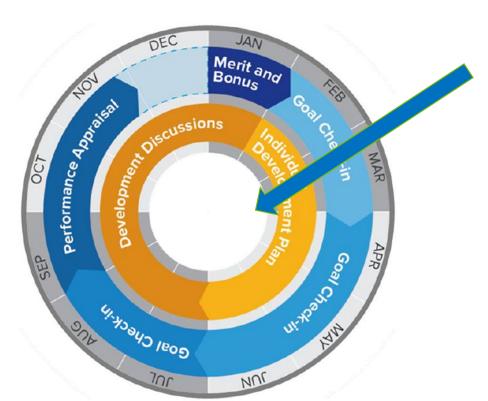

The plan aligns with the current role expectations and future professional and career goals and aspirations

• Take a presentation skills course either online or in-person before the end of the year.

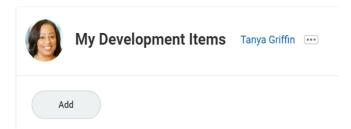
